Transforming Lives through the Power of the Word of God

This Scripture and Declaration booklet is all about asking, believing in faith and receiving. **“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened (Matthew 7:7-8, NKJV).**

Have you ever had deliverance after deliverance only to find nothing seems to change? Why is this? The Holy Spirit revealed to me that deliverance removes the driving force which allows the affliction in the first place, but one of the greatest keys to healing is by feeding the soul with the Word of God. **He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions (Psalm 107:20, NKJV).**

“It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.’” (Matthew 4:4, NKJV). Not only does the Word of God heal the emotions in the soul, but it can also heal physical afflictions. God once told me that healing begins within, then the external manifestations follow. Many physical infirmities are a direct result of wounds in our soul. Many times when these soul wounds are healed, the physical infirmity is healed also! We need to incorporate the Word of God into everything we do! Praying to God is very powerful, as is repenting and casting out unclean spirits, but we need to do more than this. The Bible tells us that we have an abundance of health, wealth, freedom, joy and prosperity waiting for us in Heaven, that we are entitled to here on earth. We pray and ask God to give us these things, but the truth is they are already ours. We need to actually claim them and declare them into being by declaring what the Word of God says. Once we learn the scriptures they will become one with us. The Word of God will seep into our hearts and human psyche and it will become natural to simply live and breathe the Word of God. How many of us pray and ask God for His help, but don't actually know what the scriptures say, or even how to use them as tools?

If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory (Colossians 3:1-4, NKJV). Walk in the Spirit and not the flesh. **Romans 8:1-11, NKJV - There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His. And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.** Walking in the spirit simply means to walk in Kingdom ways adopting a Kingdom mind-set which is directly opposite to the ways of the flesh!

When we are born-again our spirit becomes new. We need to see ourselves as spirit-beings in a body, not the other way round. We need to crucify the flesh in the areas of our lives that are weak by feeding and empowering with the word of God. We need to understand the power of Christ within us. The word of God is our spiritual weapon that will renew our minds. Until our minds are renewed we are living in the flesh!

How do we do this? ***But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you (Matthew 6:33, NKJV).*** The first step is to understand that we are righteous because the blood of Christ covers us. We cannot be blessed and inherit the Kingdom if we don't grasp this first principle. Many of us believe we are not worthy. This is condemnation in the flesh. If we are allowing this condemnation in the flesh, we are living in the flesh and not the spirit. When we live in the flesh, the devil has access to us. When we live in the spirit, the devil cannot touch us. When we live in the spirit we have access to all that Heaven has to offer. Living in the spirit is declaring Kingdom promises from the Word of God over our lives in faith and reaping the blessings. We are also renewing our carnal minds into alignment with the born-again spirit. We need to declare what the word of God says over our lives and circumstances. Many times we are dealing with strongholds (demonic fortresses) that require constant battling. What do we really believe? – What God tells us, or what circumstances and the enemy tells us. We need to change our mind-sets by breaking partnership with the lies, and partnering instead with the truth. When you believe what God tells you instead of what the enemy tells you, your whole life and circumstances will change.

The following scriptures and prayers are designed to be declared over our lives out loud every single day. Do one or two pages a day and when the whole book is complete go back to the beginning and start again. By declaring these Scriptures and declarations each day we will see huge changes in our lives. Some scriptures God has designed to simply declare and meditate on, while others require an action on our behalf. God might show us that we need to repent of a certain sin. Sometimes we may even need to prophetically 'do' what the scripture says, or change our behaviour in alignment with the scriptures: ~ ***But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does (James 1:22-25, NKJV). Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead (James 2:17, NKJV).*** We need to be on guard and use the tools that God has given us to defeat the devil. ***Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. Resist him, steadfast in the faith. (1 Peter 5:8-9, NKJV). All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work (2 Timothy 3:16-17, NKJV).*** The power of confessing the Word of God brings life. Christ's truth and light will REIGN as His Word seeps deep into our hearts! The Word of God brings healing and renews the mind.

******** Positive Scriptural confession releases the power of Jesus to help us meet our need. If we refrain from confessing we can be left at the mercy of our circumstances and negative confession can expose us to demonic and evil forces!***

READ AND MEDITATE ON THE SCRIPTURES THEN DECLARE IN FAITH OVER YOUR LIFE WHAT THEY SAY: ~ (Faith is the actual presence of things hoped for) ***'So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God' (Romans 10:17, NKJV).***

********If changes don't happen immediately keep persevering. If you struggle with continuing on in something without results then pray and ask God to give you an impartation of perseverance!***

All scriptures are from NKJV ~

Before you begin each day pray the Lord's Prayer as this is how Jesus told His disciples to pray: *Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.* --- *Matthew 6:9-13 – KJV*

Repentance Prayer - "Father God I repent for confessing what the enemy says instead of what Your Word says about me, my life and circumstances. I pray that as I confess Your Word it will fill my spirit, soul and body and I will be renewed with the mind of Christ.

For "who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ (1 Corinthians 2:16, NKJV).

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God (Romans 12:1-2, NKJV)."

Love – "Dear God I pray for a fresh infilling of Your love in Jesus name. I want to operate out of Your love each and every day. Teach me how to love people, how to truly love myself and how to love You with all of my heart, soul and strength."

Psalm 36:7-9

How precious is Your loving-kindness, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings. They are abundantly satisfied with the fullness of Your house, And You give them drink from the river of Your pleasures. For with You is the fountain of life; In Your light we see light.

Psalm 91:14

Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name.

Romans 5:5

Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Romans 5:8

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Ephesians 2:4-5

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved).

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love.

Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away.

When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things. For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part, but then I shall know just as I also am known. And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

1 John 4:7-8

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

2 Thessalonians 3:5

Now may the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patience of Christ.

Deuteronomy 6:5

You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

1 Corinthians 8:3

But if anyone loves God, this one is known by Him.

But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.

DECLARATION: “I break and renounce partnership with the lies that I need to be ‘good enough’ to receive God’s Love. I partner with the truth that God always loves me and I can ask for God’s love to infill me anytime I need it and believe that God will supply it because God’s love is unconditional. Thank You Father that nothing can separate me from Your Love.”

Protection Prayer – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray protection over (name all things you want included in the prayer like people, family, extended family, things, home and property, businesses, belongings, Ministries, Churches etc.....)”

Psalm 91

He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High
Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
I will say of the Lord, “He is my refuge and my fortress;
My God, in Him I will trust.”

Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler
And from the perilous pestilence.
He shall cover you with His feathers,
And under His wings you shall take refuge;
His truth shall be your shield and buckler.
You shall not be afraid of the terror by night,
Nor of the arrow that flies by day,
Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness,
Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.
A thousand may fall at your side,
And ten thousand at your right hand;
But it shall not come near you.
Only with your eyes shall you look,
And see the reward of the wicked.
Because you have made the Lord, who is my refuge,
Even the Most High, your dwelling place,
No evil shall befall you,
Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;
For He shall give His angels charge over you,
keep you in all your ways.
In their hands they shall bear you up,
Lest you dash your foot against a stone.
You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra,
The young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot.

Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him;
I will set him on high, because he has known My name.
He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him;
I will be with him in trouble;
I will deliver him and honor him.
With long life I will satisfy him,
And show him My salvation.

Isaiah 43:2

When you pass through the waters, I *will be* with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you.

Psalm 4:8

I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; For You alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety.

Deuteronomy 31:8

And the Lord, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed.

But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one. And we have confidence in the Lord concerning you, both that you do and will do the things we command you.

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armour of God that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armour of God that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints— and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

The Armour of God is your spiritual armour. We need to understand that this scripture is an 'action' scripture about how we should live each day. Ask God to clothe you in this armour and ask Him to show you how to use it!

Psalms 32:7

You are my hiding place;
You shall preserve me from trouble;
You shall surround me with songs of deliverance.

Romans 8:31-32

What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

1 Samuel 2:9

He will guard the feet of His saints,
But the wicked shall be silent in darkness.
For by strength no man shall prevail.

2 Samuel 22:3-4

The God of my strength, in whom I will trust;
My shield and the horn of my salvation,
My stronghold and my refuge;
My Saviour, You save me from violence.
I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised;
So shall I be saved from my enemies?

Psalms 5:11

But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; Let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; Let those also who love Your name be joyful in You.

DECLARATION: “Thank You Father God that if You are for us, then who can be against us.”

Fear/Worry Prayer – “Dear God in Jesus name I ask You to deliver me from all fear and worry.”

1 John 4:18

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

Hebrews 13: 5-6

For He Himself has said, “I will never leave you nor forsake you.” So we may boldly say: “The LORD is my helper; I will not fear.”

2 Timothy 1:7

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

1 Peter 5:7

Casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

Psalm 27:1

The LORD *is* my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The LORD *is* the strength of my life; Of whom shall I be afraid?

Isaiah 41:10

“Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.”

Philippians 4:6-9

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Meditate on These Things

Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.

PRAY: “Dear God in Jesus name I pray the following requests to You (*name everything that is concerning you*) and lay them at the foot of the cross. I praise You and thank You for (*name everything that You are thankful for*) – Amen.”

Luke 12:22-26

Then He said to His disciples, “Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; nor about the body, what you will put on. Life is more than food, and the body is more than clothing. Consider the ravens, for they neither sow nor reap, which have neither storehouse nor barn; and God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds? And which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature? If you then are not able to do the least, why are you anxious for the rest”?

Romans 8:15

For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, ‘Abba, Father’.

1 John 4:4

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

1 Corinthians 15:57

But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Isaiah 54:14

In righteousness you shall be established; You shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; And from terror, for it shall not come near you.

Deuteronomy 28:13

And the Lord will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you today, and are careful to observe them.

God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear.

Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you."

He will not be afraid of evil tidings;
His heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord.
His heart is established;
He will not be afraid,
Until he sees his desire upon his enemies.

I sought the LORD, and He heard me,

Whenever I am afraid,
I will trust in You.

Isaiah 35:4

Say to those who are fearful-hearted,

But a good word makes it glad.

DECLARATION: "I renounce the lies and all partnerships I have formed with fear. I instead choose to partner with trust, peace and God's perfect love which casts out fear. Thank You Father that I am a beloved child of God."

Dismantling the enemy Prayer – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray that You will stand beside me as we remove the enemy from this home and occupants. I command all demons to leave me, my family, my house, my home, my property, my belongings and my pets in the name of Jesus Christ.” ***** *It is a good idea to pray the prayer and then walk around your entire house whilst reading a different Scripture within every room (including the outside).*

1 John 3:8

For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Luke 10:19

Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will injure you.

Revelation 12:11

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

Colossians 1:13

He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

Matthew 18:18

Assuredly I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

1 John 4:4

You are of God little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is of the world.

John 1:10-14

He was in the world and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1:1-5

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

2 Corinthians 10:4-5

For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ.

Isaiah 14:12

How you are fallen from Heaven, O lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground.

Philippians 2:5-11

Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

James 4:6-7

But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble." Therefore submit to God. "Resist the devil and he will flee from you."

Colossians 1:15-17

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.

Hebrews 1:3-4

Who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become so much better than the angels, as He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.

Romans 16:20

And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.

And the Lord said, "Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren."

2 Timothy 4:18

And the Lord will deliver me from every evil work and preserve me for His heavenly kingdom. To Him be glory forever and ever. Amen!

Hebrews 12:1-2

Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

DECLARATION: "Greater is He living in me, than He who is of the world."

Pride – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray for humility. I relinquish pride and ask You to strip all pride from me so You can fully reign in me.”

Isaiah 2:11-12

The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, The haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, And the Lord alone shall be exalted in that day. For the day of the Lord of hosts Shall come upon everything proud and lofty, Upon everything lifted up—And it shall be brought low.

Psalms 25:9

The humble He guides in justice, And the humble He teaches His way.

1 Peter 5:5

Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble.

Mark 10:45

For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.

2 Corinthians 12:7-10

And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. And He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ’s sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

Philippians 2:5-8

Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

2 Chronicles 12:12

When he humbled himself, the wrath of the Lord turned from him, so as not to destroy him completely; and things also went well in Judah.

Job 22:29

When they cast you down, and you say, “Exaltation will come”! Then He will save the humble person.

Proverbs 11:2

When pride comes, then comes shame; But with the humble is wisdom.

James 4:10

Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up.

Luke 14:11

For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

2 Chronicles 7:14

If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

DECLARATION: “I am clothed in the humility of Christ. I am guided in Justice, and am taught by God.”

Praying for Salvation for others – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray for the salvation of *(name the people you want saved).*”

Jeremiah 24:7

Then I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am the LORD; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, for they shall return to Me with their whole heart.

Revelation 3:20

Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.

Jeremiah 29:12-13

Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.

Isaiah 43:1

But now, thus says the Lord, who created you, “O Jacob”, And He who formed you, “O Israel: Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; You are Mine.”

Malachi 3:6-7

“For I am the Lord, I do not change; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob. Yet from the days of your fathers you have gone away from My ordinances and have not kept them. Return to Me, and I will return to you,” Says the Lord of hosts.

Acts 16:31

So they said, “Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household”.

DECLARATION: “Thank You Father God that You love these people and that You have called them by name.”

Confusion Prayer – “In Jesus name I pray for a sound mind, please deliver me from all doubt and confusion.”

1 Corinthians 14:33

For God is not the author of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints.

2 Timothy 1:7

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

1 Corinthians 2:16

For ‘who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him’? But we have the mind of Christ.

Ephesians 1:18

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.

1 Corinthians 2:12-14

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. These things we also speak, not in words which man’s wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

DECLARATION: “I have the mind of Christ.”

Peace Prayer – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray for an impartation of Your peace into my life and circumstances.”

John 16:33

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.

John 14:27

Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Isaiah 54:10

“For the mountains shall depart, And the hills be removed, But My kindness shall not depart from you, Nor shall My covenant of peace be removed,” Says the LORD, who has mercy on you.

Isaiah 26:3-4

You will keep him in perfect peace,
Whose mind is stayed on You,
Because he trusts in You.
Trust in the Lord forever,
For in YAH, the Lord, is everlasting strength.

Romans 5:1

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 2:14-16

Christ Our Peace: For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.

Colossians 3:15-17

And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. And whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him. **Praise and worship and thank the Lord*

Ephesians 6:15

And having shod your feet with the preparation of the Gospel of peace.

Jeremiah 29:12-13

Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.

Romans 8:6

For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

DECLARATION: “My heart and mind is protected with God’s peace because I trust in Him.”

Tiredness Prayer – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray for strength. Please deliver me from all weariness, slumber and tiredness.”

Matthew 11:28

“Come to Me, all you who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.”

Ephesians 6:10

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.

2 Corinthians 12:9

And He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.”

Galatians 6:9

And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.

Hebrews 4:1-11

Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it. For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it. For we who have believed do enter that rest, as He has said:

“So I swore in My wrath, They shall not enter My rest, although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.” For He has spoken in a certain place of the seventh day in this way: And God rested on the seventh day from all His works; and again in this place: “They shall not enter My rest.”

Since therefore it remains that some must enter it, and those to whom it was first preached did not enter because of disobedience, again He designates a certain day, saying in David, “Today, after such a long time, as it has been said: Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts.”

For if Joshua had given them rest, then He would not afterward have spoken of another day. There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. For he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his works as God did from His. Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience.

Exodus 33:14

And He said, ‘My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest.’”

Isaiah 40:28-31

Have you not known? Have you not heard?
The everlasting God, the Lord, The Creator of the ends of the earth,
Neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable.
He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength.
Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall,
But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength;
They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary,
They shall walk and not faint.

DECLARATION: “The joy of the Lord is my strength. Thank You Jesus that because I believe in You, I am able to enter into Your rest.”

**Enter into God’s rest by putting on some worship music and soak in His presence.*

Hope and strength Prayer – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray for an impartation of Your strength and hope.”

Romans 15:13

Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Psalms 29:11

The LORD will give strength to His people, The LORD will bless His people with peace.

Deuteronomy 20:4

For the LORD your God *is* He who goes with you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you.

Psalms 34:14-18

Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it. The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous. And His ears are open to their cry. The face of the LORD is against those who do evil, To cut off the remembrance of them from the earth. The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears, And delivers them out of all their troubles. The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart, And saves such as have a contrite spirit.

Deuteronomy 31:6

Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the LORD your God, He *is* the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you.

Philippians 3:14

I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

1 Corinthians 15:57

But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Jeremiah 20:11

But the LORD *is* with me as a mighty, awesome One. Therefore my persecutors will stumble, and will not prevail. They will be greatly ashamed, for they will not prosper. Their everlasting confusion will never be forgotten.

1 John 5:4

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith.

DECLARATION: "I am strengthened with all might according to His glorious power."

Sad Prayer – "Dear God in Jesus name I pray for the impartation of joy and laughter."

Nehemiah 8:10

Do not sorrow, for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

Isaiah 61:3

To comfort all who mourn, To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for
ashes, The oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness.

John 15:11-17

These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be
full.

John 16:20

Most assuredly, I say to you that you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice; and you
will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy.

John 16:22

Therefore you now have sorrow; but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice, and your
joy no one will take from you.

1 Thessalonians 5:20

For you are our glory and joy

DECLARATION: "I renounce all partnerships I have formed with sorrow and heaviness. I
partner with and release joy. Thank You Jesus that Your joy remains in me and that Your joy
is full."

****Start praising the Lord***

Patience Prayer – “Father God in Jesus name I pray for patience, endurance and self control. I ask that you would help me to wait patiently in all situations I face.”

Hebrews 10:36

For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise.

Isaiah 40:31

But those who wait on the LORD
Shall renew their strength;
They shall mount up with wings like eagles,
They shall run and not be weary,
They shall walk and not faint.

Ephesians 4:2-3

With all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

2 Thessalonians 3:5

Now may the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patience of Christ.

2 Peter 3:9

The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

Psalm 37:7

Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him.

James 5:7-8

Healing Prayer – “Dear God in Jesus name I release healing for..... (name all things and people needing healing).”

Bless the LORD, O my soul;
And all that is within me, bless His holy name!
Bless the LORD, O my soul,
And forget not all His benefits:
Who forgives all your iniquities,
Who heals all your diseases,
Who redeems your life from destruction,
Who crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies.

Psalm 107:19-20

Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble,
And He saved them out of their distresses.
He sent His word and healed them,
And delivered them from their destructions.

Proverbs 4:20-22

My son, give attention to my words;
Incline your ear to my sayings.
Do not let them depart from your eyes;
Keep them in the midst of your heart;
For they are life to those who find them,
And health to all their flesh.

Philippians 2:9-11

Therefore God has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name. That at the name of Jesus every knee must bow, of those in Heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God the Father.

And carried our sorrows;

To undo the heavy burdens,
To let the oppressed go free,
And that you break every yoke?
Is it not to share your bread with the hungry,
And that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out;
When you see the naked, that you cover him,
And not hide yourself from your own flesh?

Your healing shall spring forth speedily,
And your righteousness shall go before you;
The glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard.

And satisfy your soul in drought,
And strengthen your bones;
You shall be like a watered garden,
And like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.
Those from among you
Shall build the old waste places;
You shall raise up the foundations of many generations;
And you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach,
The Restorer of Streets to Dwell In.

DECLARATION: "Every disease, every infirmity, every problem has to submit itself to the name of Jesus. The Spirit of Him who raised Christ from the dead dwells in me and will give life to my mortal body. "I demand (*name of disease*) to bow down to the name of Jesus and come into divine order. Thank You Jesus that by Your stripes I am healed."

Deception Prayer– “In Jesus name I pray for protection against deception. I clothe myself in the belt of truth. I pray that You will deliver me from any deception I am under. I pray for Your truth to be released to thwart the power of the enemy.”

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”

2 Timothy 2:24-26

And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will.

1 John 5:6

This is He who came by water and blood—Jesus Christ; not only by water, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who bears witness, because the Spirit is truth.

1 John 2:27

But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.

John 8:31-32

Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, “If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”

John 16:13

However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

DECLARATION: “I am sanctified in Your Word Lord Jesus, because Your Word is truth. Thank You that Your light and truth lead and guide me. I break and renounce all partnerships with deception. I partner with and release truth.”

Forgiveness – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray that You will forgive me of my sins as I forgive those who sin against me.”

**Ask the Holy Spirit to show you who you need to forgive. Name them and verbally say that you forgive them, and then bless them. (May need to also forgive yourself, or even God for the times you perceived He let you down)*

Proverbs 20:22

Do not say, “I will recompense evil”;
Wait for the LORD, and He will save you.

Colossians 1:13-15

He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

Matthew 5:44

“But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you.”

Acts 10:43

To Him all the prophets witness that, through His name, whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sins.

Having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him.

Colossians 3:12-15

Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.

Romans 8:2

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

Psalms 51:9-10

Hide Your face from my sins, And blot out all my iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Acts 13:38-39

Therefore let it be known to you, brethren, that through this Man is preached to you the forgiveness of sins; and by Him everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses.

Colossians 2:13-14

And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

DECLARATION: "I am forgiven of all my sins and washed in the blood in accordance with the riches of His grace."

Curses Prayer – "Father God I pray that all curses afflicting me and my family will be removed in Jesus name. I forgive anyone who has cursed me and I am sorry for any curses I have put on myself and others and I pray for them to be removed also in Jesus name."

Isaiah 54:17

No weapon formed against you shall prosper,
And every tongue which rises against you in judgment
You shall condemn.

This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord,
And their righteousness is from Me,"
Says the Lord.

Proverbs 26:2

Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow,
So a curse without cause shall not alight.

1 Peter 3:8-9

Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous; not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.

Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree") that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Luke 6:28

Bless those who curse you, and pray for those who spitefully use you.

Romans 12:14

Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.

DECLARATION: "No weapon formed against me shall prosper, and every tongue which rises up against me You will condemn, this is my heritage as a servant of the Lord, and my righteousness is from Jesus.

Critical Spirit – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray that You would help release from the critical way I judge and perceive people and situations. I pray that You would teach me how to love people.”

Luke 6:37

“Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.”

Matthew 7:3

And why do you look at the speck in your brother’s eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye?

Ephesians 4:29-32

Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honour giving preference to one another; not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer; distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.

Let brotherly love continue.

Mark 12:31

And the second, like it, is this: "You shall love your neighbour as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these."

Colossians 3:12-15

Therefore, as *the* elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also *must do*. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.

2 Peter 1:5-7

But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love.

1 Peter 4:10

As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

Acts 20:35

I have shown you in every way, by labouring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive'.

So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you? You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. If I then, *your* Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.

DECLARATION: "Thank You Jesus that You can give me the ability to see people and situations through Your eyes."

Addictions/Weaknesses – “Dear God in Jesus name I pray that You will aide me in breaking all habits, weaknesses and addictions.”

Philippians 4:11-13

Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content: I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

2 Corinthians 2:14

Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.

Romans 6:17

But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered.

James 4:6-7

But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: “God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble.” Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

Ephesians 6:13

Therefore take up the whole armour of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Hebrews 2:18

For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.

What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it? Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.

And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves of uncleanness, and of lawlessness leading to more lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves of righteousness for holiness.

For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. What fruit did you have then in the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life.

2 Peter 2:9-10

Then the Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust under punishment for the day of judgment, and especially those who walk according to the flesh in the lust of uncleanness and despise authority. They are presumptuous, self-willed.

1 Corinthians 9:24-27

Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain *it*. And everyone who competes *for the prize* is temperate in all things. Now they *do it* to obtain a perishable crown, but we *for an imperishable crown*.

Therefore I run thus: not with uncertainty. Thus I fight: not as *one who* beats the air. But I discipline my body and bring *it* into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified.

Titus 1:7-9

For a bishop must be blameless, as a steward of God, not self-willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, not violent, not greedy for money, but hospitable, a lover of what is good, sober-minded, just, holy, self-controlled, holding fast the faithful word as he has been taught, that he may be able, by sound doctrine, both to exhort and convict those who contradict.

Titus 2:11-14

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself *His* own special people, zealous for good works.

Galatians 5:21- 23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

2 Timothy 2:11-12

This is a faithful saying:

For if we died with *Him*,

We shall also live with *Him*.

If we endure,

We shall also reign with *Him*.

If we deny *Him*,

He also will deny us.

DECLARATION: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

Inferiority/Unworthiness Prayer – “I pray Father God in Jesus name that You will help me claim back my self-worth. Please show me how much You love me, and that I am worthy. Show me who I am through Your eyes.”

Psalm 139: 13-18

For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother’s womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvellous are Your works, And that my soul knows very well. My frame was not hidden from You. When I was made in secret, And skilfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, The days fashioned for me, When as yet there were none of them.

How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand; When I awake, I am still with You.

Romans 8:31-39

God’s Everlasting Love

What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? Who shall bring a charge against God’s elect? It is God who justifies. Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written: “For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.”

Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

John 1:12

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name.

Ephesians 1:4-6

Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.

Isaiah 43:4

Since you were precious in My sight, You have been honoured, and I have loved you.

Hebrews 4:16

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

For if by the one man’s offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

1 Thessalonians 5:23-24

Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. He who calls you *is* faithful, who also will do *it*.

DECLARATION: "I have on the righteousness of Christ. My flesh will bow down to the righteousness of Christ. I am worthy, I am clean, I am righteous, I am loved, I am a daughter/son of God, I am special."

Wisdom Prayer – “Heavenly Father in Jesus name I pray for wisdom in all things.”

Psalm 111:10

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom; A good understanding have all those who do His commandments. His praise endures forever.

Matthew 7:24-25

“Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.

James 1:5-6

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.

James 3:17

But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

These things we also speak, not in words which man’s wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual. But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one. For “who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?” But we have the mind of Christ.

Colossians 3:9-10

Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him.

2 Corinthians 4:6

For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Colossians 2:7

Rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.

Proverbs 24:3-4

Through wisdom a house is built,
And by understanding it is established;
By knowledge the rooms are filled

To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus. To this end I also labor, striving according to His working which works in me mightily.

Psalm 119:98-99

You, through Your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies; For they are ever with me. I have more understanding than all my teachers, For Your testimonies are my meditation.

Proverbs 2:6-7

For the Lord gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding; He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly.

DECLARATION: “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of my wisdom.”

Temptation – “Father God I pray that You would help me to resist all temptations. I pray for the fruit of the spirit self-control to operate within me.”

1 Corinthians 10:13

No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*.

Hebrews 2:18

For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.

James 1:12-13

Blessed *is* the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. Let no one say when he is tempted, “I am tempted by God”; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.

DECLARATION: “Jesus is able to help me when I am being tested.”

Man and Wife and Family Prayer – “Father God I pray for family unity, togetherness and peace. I pray for an impartation of love for one another, and a bond that will withstand and not break.”

Ephesians 5:31

“For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.”

Ecclesiastes 4:12

And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

1 Corinthians 11:3

The head over every man is Christ, the head over woman is man and the head over Christ is God.

1 Peter 3: 1-7

Submission to Husbands: Wives, likewise, be submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives, when they observe your chaste conduct accompanied by fear. Do not let your adornment be merely outward—arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on fine apparel— rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God. For in this manner, in former times, the holy women who trusted in God also adorned themselves, being submissive to their own husbands, as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, whose daughters you are if you do good and are not afraid with any terror. A Word to Husbands: Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honour to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.

Ephesians 5:25-28

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself.

PRAY: Husband to wife: “I honour you, cherish you and affirm you as my wife. I give you authority over my body in Jesus name and ask God to bless you.”

Wife to husband: “I honour and respect you. I submit to you and acknowledge your protection, love and support as head over me. I give you authority over my body in Jesus name and I ask God to bless you - Amen.”

Together: “We submit to You Lord Jesus as Headship over us, our marriage and our family.”

Ephesians 6:1-4

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. “Honor your father and mother,” which is the first commandment with promise: “that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.”

And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.

DECLARATION: “We have family unity, blessings and peace. Thank You that Christ is the head of our family.”

Trials – “In Jesus name I pray Father God for strength and endurance, and all other necessary tools to withstand trials, hardships, persecutions and disappointments.”

2 Thessalonians 1:3-5

We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other, so that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure, which is manifest evidence of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you also suffer.

2 Corinthians 4:8-10

We are hard-pressed on every side, yet not crushed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed - always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body

Romans 8:28

And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

1 Peter 1:3-9

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of your souls.

Luke 22:42

“Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done.”

Ephesians 3:13

Therefore I ask that you do not lose heart at my tribulations for you, which is your glory.

Romans 5:1-5

Faith Triumphs in Trouble

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; and perseverance, character; and character, hope. Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

1 Peter 5:10

But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.

James 1:12

Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

Rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer.

2 Corinthians 1:3-7

Comfort in Suffering

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God. For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so our consolation also abounds through Christ. Now if we are afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effective for enduring the same sufferings which we also suffer. Or if we are comforted, it is for your consolation and salvation. And our hope for you is steadfast, because we know that as you are partakers of the sufferings, so also you will partake of the consolation.

2 Corinthians 4:16-18

Seeing the Invisible

Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Philippians 3:8-12

Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith; that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.

Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.

Which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets: that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel, of which I became a minister according to the gift of the grace of God given to me by the effective working of His power.

To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, and to make all see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created all things through Jesus Christ; to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places, according to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.

1 Peter 2:4-5

Coming to Him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious, you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 1:2-11

To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ: Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Fruitful Growth in the Faith

But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. For he who lacks these things is short-sighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.

Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble; for so an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

DECLARATION: " I am one of God's living stones and am being built up (in Christ) as a spiritual house."

Unbelief - "Dear God I pray that You would help me with my unbelief."

Mark 11:24

Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

He who has ears to hear, let him hear!

No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you. You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.

Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

Spiritual Gifts Prayer – “In Jesus name Father God I pray for spiritual gifts. Your word says to desire spiritual gifts. I pray that You bestow these gifts upon me so that I can bring glory to Your name. Show me what these gifts are and how to use them for Your glory.”

1 Corinthians 12:4-11

There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

1 Corinthians 12:27-31

Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues. Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles? Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret? But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way.

Romans 12:3-8

For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith. For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another. Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith; or ministry, let us use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

DECLARATION: “Thank You Jesus that you have given me supernatural gifts to build up Your body and glorify Your name.”

Burdens Prayer - “Father God in Jesus name I release my burdens to You. I lay them at the foot of the cross. Help me to never again pick them back up. Teach me how to be forever free of these burdens.”

Matthew 11:28

Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Isaiah 10:27

It shall come to pass in that day, That his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, And his yoke from your neck, And the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.

And He shall sustain you;
He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.

DECLARATION: “I take up Your yolk Jesus which is easy, and Your burden which is light.”

Death/Fear of Death Prayer – “Father God in Jesus name I pray for deliverance for myself and my family from all death and destruction, as well as spiritual death and fear of death. Awaken my spirit/soul and body so I can be walking fully in the calling You have for me. Deliver me from all things that prevent my fullness in You.” I pray for such a sense of peace and trust in You that the enemy will no longer be able to make me afraid of death, In Jesus name.”

John 6:47

Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has everlasting life.

John 10:28

And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

John 11:26

And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?”

John 17:3

And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

Hebrews 2:15

And release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

**Look for any unforgiveness and release, as this can be one of the roots of anger*

Ephesians 4:26-28

"Be angry, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil.

Galatians 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

James 1:19-20

So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

Proverbs 16:32

*He who is slow to anger is better than the mighty,

The Desires of your Heart Prayer – “Dear God you know and see the desires within my heart. Lord Jesus I desire(*name them*)..... I pray that You will give me the desires of my heart. If my desires are not in alignment with Your desires, then I ask for You to fill my heart with Your desires, In Jesus name.”

Psalm 20:4

May He grant you according to your heart's desire, And fulfill all your purpose.

Psalm 145:18-19

The LORD *is* near to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth. He will fulfil the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear their cry and save them.

Psalm 37:4-5

Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the Lord, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass.

Matthew 6:6-8

But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.
